Treasurer's Report:

We have \$6,773.16 in our account.

Wine and Music Event Income-\$11,035.77 and Expenses were \$6,449.26. We made about \$4,600 profit.

The train that is used for Octoberfest is maintained by the Elks. Any of the donations goes to the maintenance of the train. The Elks helps fund the Halloween parade. The give free hot dogs and soda to people who march in the parade.

The blockade for the parade needs to be manned. There is a total of 19 stations. The Flagger Force will come in with 10 people. It's \$2400 instead of \$1600 because it is time and a half. The Borough is paying \$850. A donation was given by Grace on Broadway. They need \$1,300. We want people to come into the downtown. That is one of the reasons we started HBBA.

John-2nd Ward Fire

He is the sitting president. They would like to have a boot or hat in are businesses if people don't want a boot or hat they can have a container in the business that would be lockable. Someone would come in and empty it once or twice a month. A list can be given to Anthony or Janet Kichline and we will give it to John.

Anthony made a motion to give the Elks \$750 to pay for the flaggers for the Halloween Parade and was 2nd by Jill. All in favor.
